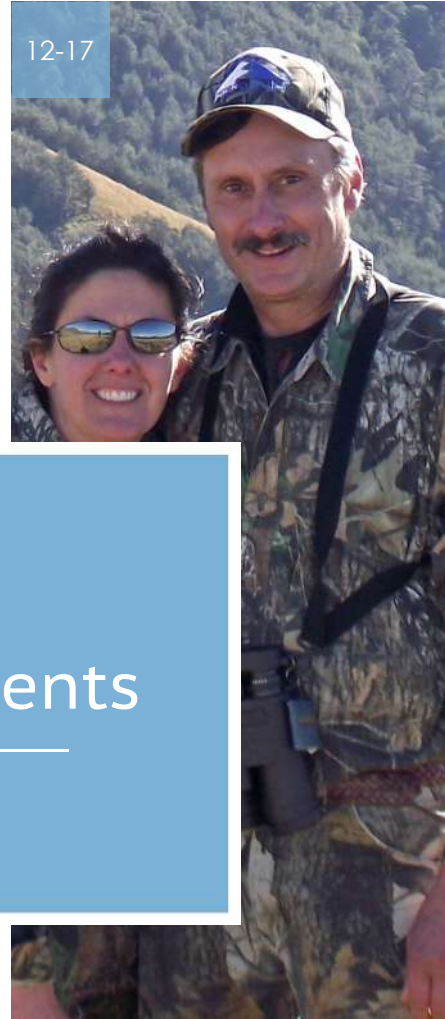

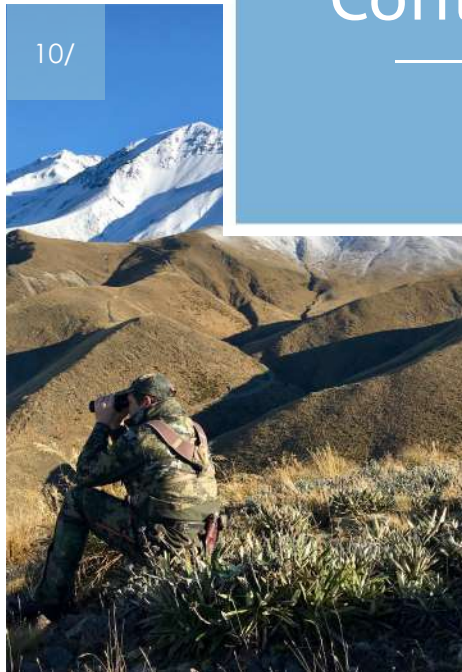

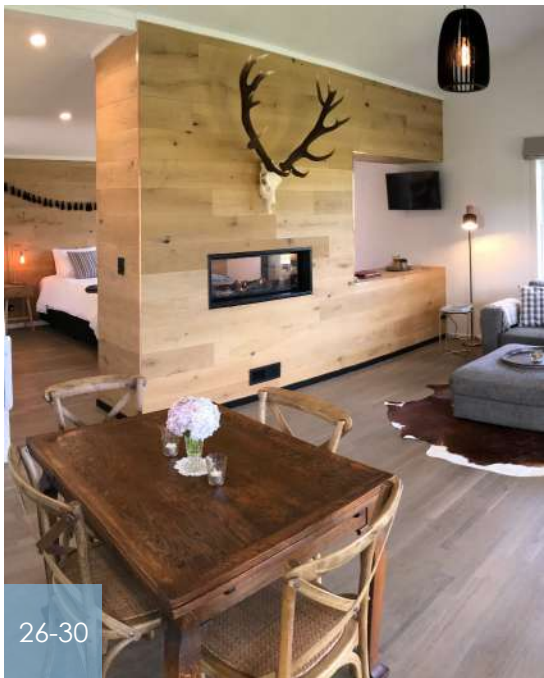

Greeted by Myriam and Nigel personally at the airport, they make it effortless, relaxing and instantly friendly.

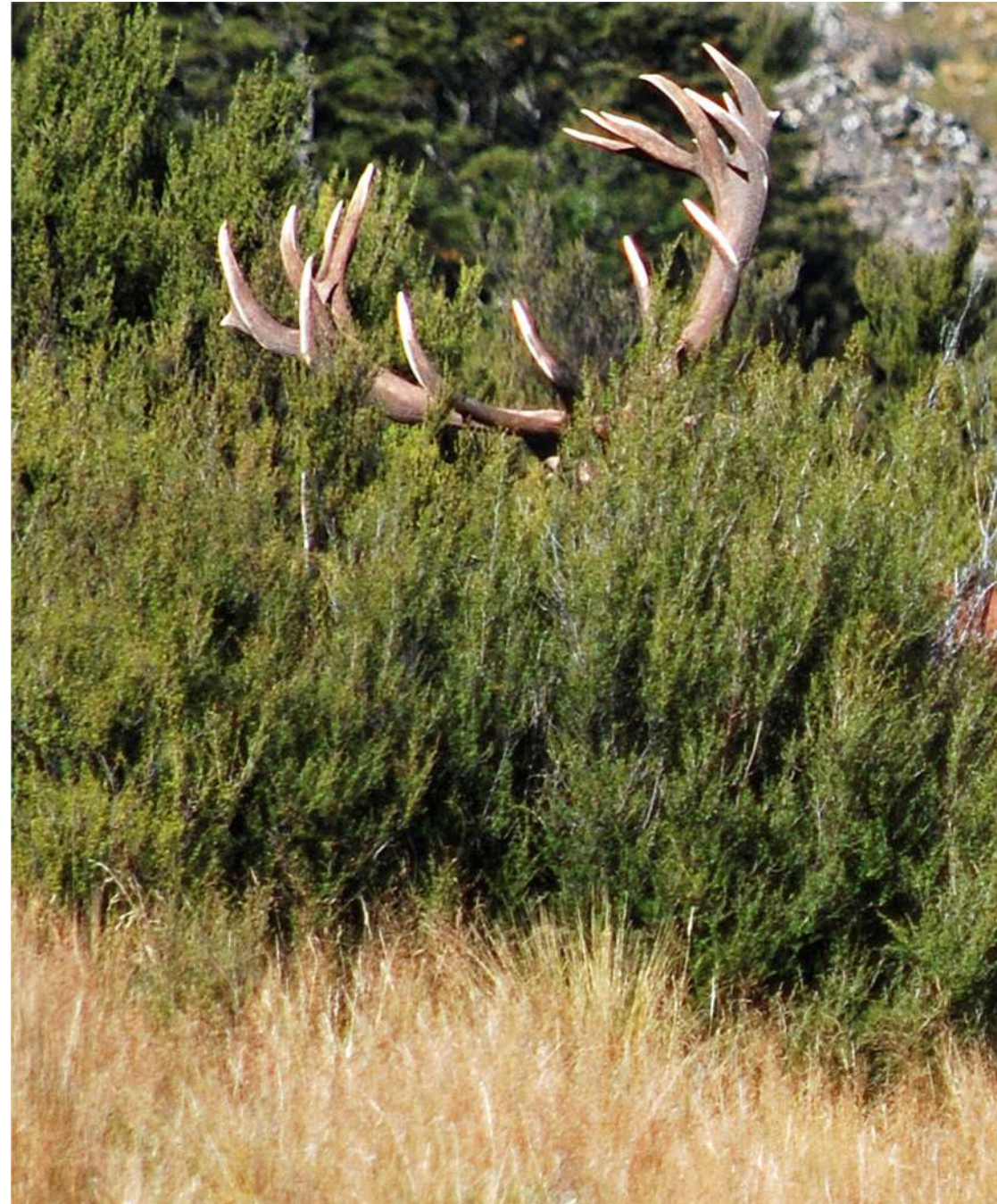
Within a few hours you're showered, refreshed, having some laughs and bursting with excitement for the Southern Alps hunting adventure that materializes in front of you.

The landscapes blow your mind, the air is so clear and crisp, then you hear it for the first time... The unbelievable rutting roar of the Red Stag. Looking at each other with uncontainable smiles, satisfaction takes hold. You're stalking Red Stag in Middle Earth.

NEW ZEALAND RED STAG

Red Stag in New Zealand is on the bucket list of most hunters. As your senses absorb the new smells, vegetation types, birdsong and that interesting accent being whispered by your guide, that list becomes a reality. The pounding heart in your chest increases as you hear the stag roaring and their rutting smell drifts along in the mist. Yet to catch a glimpse of those massive heavy timbered antlers, your excitement levels are almost maxed out.

The clash of antlers directs spotting scopes and binoculars to a tussock clearing on the edge of a forested gully. Your first Red Stag in the flesh is a sight that you will never forget. Containing your excitement, your guide explains that he wishes to show you many stags over the coming day or two due to their individuality and uniqueness. "You will know when you find the right one, it just happens... no rush on the first morning. Lets have some fun!"





NOT JUST THE RED STAGS

You're impressed by the preparation, professionalism and effort that your outfitting team is making to ensure every element of your week runs smoothly. With no stone left unturned, you feel totally relaxed, exploring together the vast private properties that are exclusively your hunting grounds for the days ahead.

Spending many hours with quality optics, your guide explains the distinctiveness of each animal to you. But it's not just the Red Stag that you enjoy watching through the lens. Other New Zealand species constantly distract you from the focus of finding your trophy. Croaking Fallow bucks, Arapawa rams and some mighty Elk constantly catch your eye.



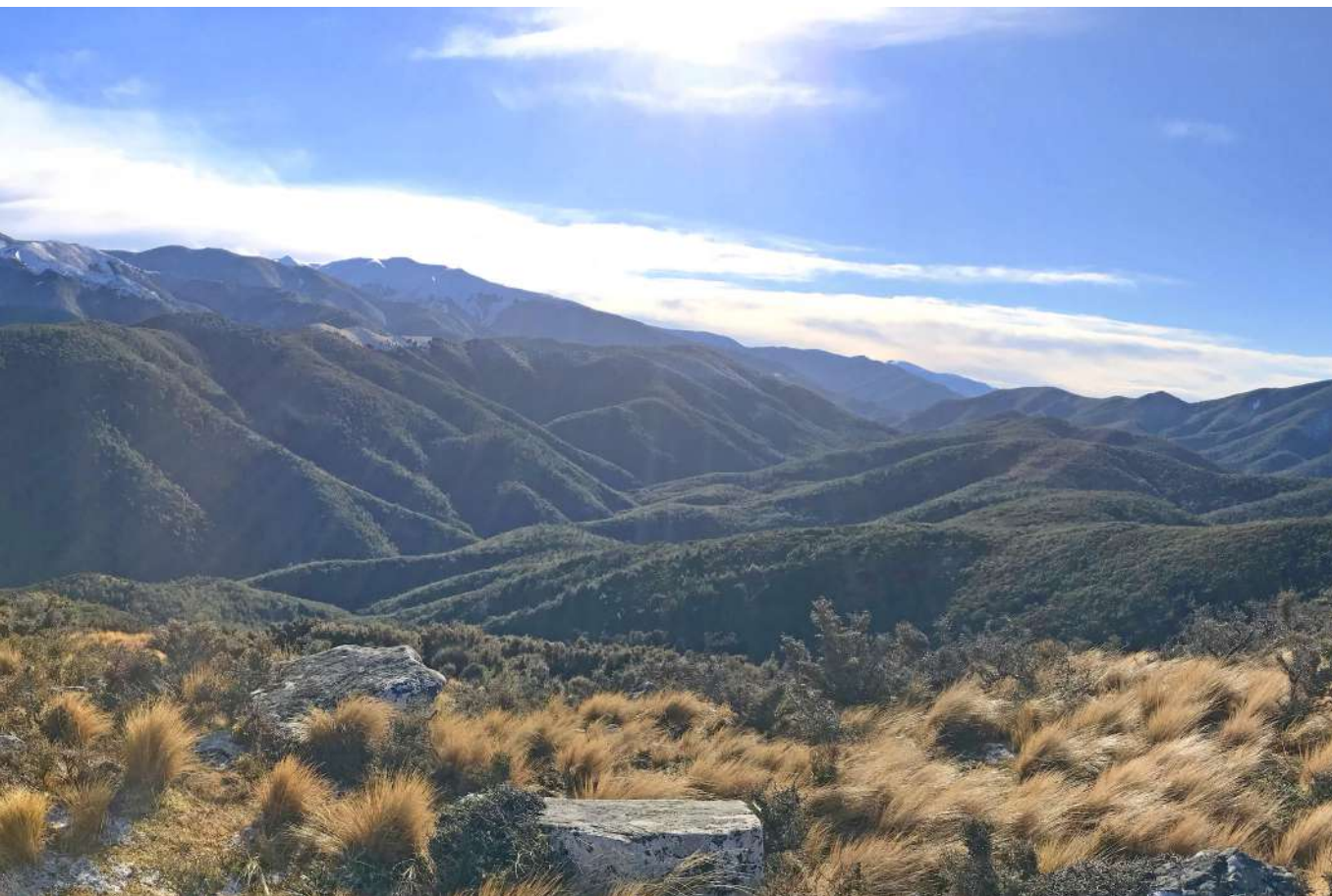


KING OF THE ALPS

Up high in the tops your guide points out the first mob of nanny Tahr grazing a rocky and grassed face with ledges. It's your first look at these small looking goats originally from the Himalayas.

From behind a large rock walks an animal with far greater body size and a huge mane displayed impressively. Pointing his nose while poking out his tongue, smelling the air from the group of nannies. He's constantly trying to defend his harem of females from younger bulls in the group. A distraction that gives you as the hunter an opportunity to stalk in closer. Your guide whispers "That's a great bull Tahr! Let's get walking!" Your heart is pounding again... before your first step.





GREAT STALKS

Hunting a chosen animal that will sit pride of place in your home is one of the many pleasures you gain from this pastime. The animal will be transformed to a piece of art in its own right, bringing you strong memories and story telling moments for the rest of your life.

Viewing animals and planning stalks with your guiding team, you realize that they are always assessing your capabilities and matching these to suit the opportunities that present themselves. You feel comfortable in their leadership, guidance and recommendations. They are professional and fun communicators, also ensuring that your safety is of the foremost importance.

Following your guide while using the terrain, vegetation and weather conditions to your advantage. You skillfully close the gap between the animal that you have fallen for and a suitable spot. You prepare to make a final assessment and take a calculated shot.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HARVEST

For most, the hunt experience brings us back to a primal, natural state of peace and selflessness in nature. Whilst the trophy of your dreams drives the adventure, responsible hunter ethics are always important. Ensuring fair-chase stalks set the hunter up for a quick and effective harvest shot, is a critical element in the hunt. But that's only a starting point in the process.

All quality prime meat cuts from accessible trophies are recovered and put to good use. Tasting wild game during a hunt is an important element for most. Myriam & Nigel take pride in creating meals from game for your experience.

Backcountry New Zealand is a very proud supplier of organic wild meat to the Christchurch City Mission - a Christian social service agency. Not only will your hunt be an adventure, you will taste the game meat of New Zealand and have comfort in the fact that your harvest assists in feeding those less fortunate in life.



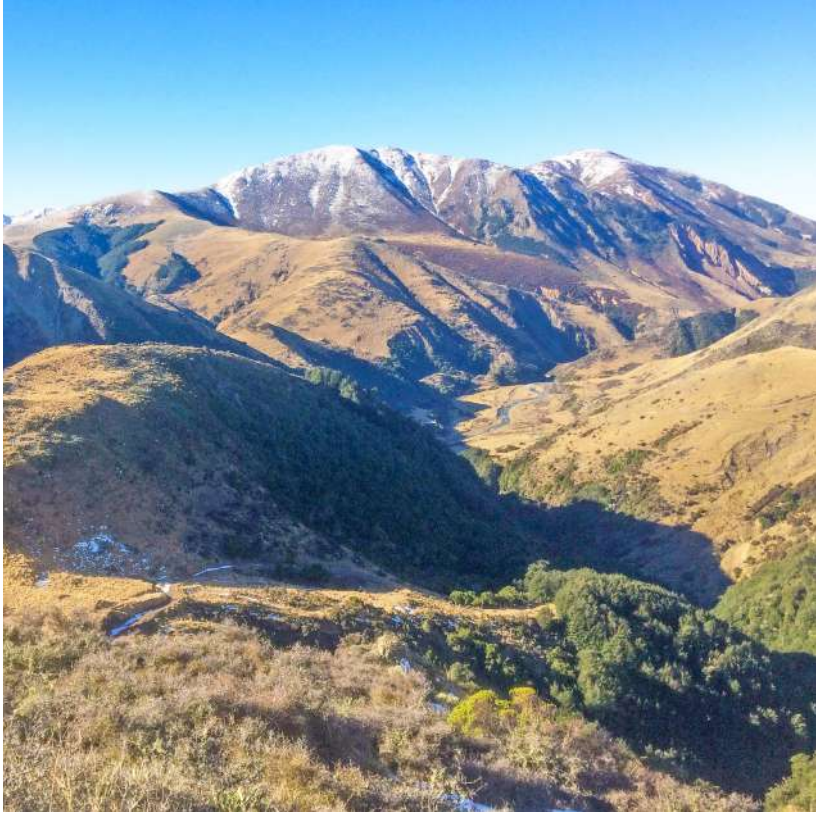

HUNT PROPERTIES

Red Stag and Fallow hunting areas consist of native forests, scrub & grasslands. Tahr & Chamois are alpine species and are often located in steeper conditions. With great 4WD and hiking access on all properties, Nigel & Myriam are able to get clients into all the species they desire. The Birts' own their own 3000+ acre red stag property and hunt on private lands up to 49,000 acres for Tahr & Chamois.







HUNT EQUIPMENT & FIREARMS

Prior to your hunting trip, we send you a detailed list of equipment, clothing and other items you should pack. Sturdy footwear is preferred, such as the Cabela's Meindl Denali boots or similar. We prefer that technical hunting pants are worn rather than jeans. We recommend a layering system of clothing, as highly insulated items get too hot when moving and walking.

Firearms are available for clients who do not wish to bring their own. Bringing a hunting rifle into New Zealand is a relatively straight forward process. Shooting distances will vary from 80 - 300 yards. Any calibre between the .270 and .300 Win Mag is adequate for New Zealand hunting conditions. For bow hunters, be proficient with your shot up to 50 yards (45 meters).



THE SEASONS

For hunting New Zealand deer species, Red deer, Wapiti (Elk) and Fallow deer: Hunts run late February to July, (this is late summer to winter, with ruts being mid March to late April in fall). The greatest choice of large trophies occur in the months of March and April.

Hunting New Zealand's alpine species, Tahr and Chamois: Best months are May to August (ruts being May and June). Combine trout fishing with your hunts during February and March.

EXPEDITING, BOW HUNTING & LOCATION

We have a fantastic New Zealand taxidermist who takes care of your trophies. In 15+ years of working with them we have never had an issue or concern. The taxidermists can either taxidermy and ship your trophies for you, or expedite to your own taxidermist. Prior to your hunt we send you all the taxidermy information and options for your review, along with meeting the taxidermist during your stay.

We welcome bow hunters on our hunting trips. Be aware that we may ask you to add a day or two of hunting time when structuring your trip. The respect of the animal in the process is important to us which is detailed within the booking process.

Our Base

Our base is located in Staveley, Canterbury, one hour inland from Christchurch on the South Island. At the base of the Southern Alps, our hunting grounds extend across these with private properties ranging from 3,000 to 49,000 acres. All are within an hours drive to provide the best hunting opportunities for all species. We own our Red stag property of 3000+ acres, where the population is well managed to maximize trophy quality and sustain winter grazing.





TOURING OPTIONS & NON-HUNTERS

Ensuring that non-hunters have as much fun and excitement as the hunters is a factor of the hunt we take seriously. Non-hunters are welcome to tag along during a hunt, or we can coordinate additional guided or non-guided activities to explore. Options range from short walks, Lord of the Rings film sites, shopping at local towns, visiting art galleries, a jet-boat trip or horse ride to name a few.

For those wanting a little more, choose a charter with our local scenic flight company to the shopping and adventure town of Queenstown. On the way seeing some of the South Island's most spectacular scenery.

Upon request during the booking phase, we can coordinate charter flights, hotels in Christchurch and Queenstown, rental cars and recommend to you the must see destinations.

Many guests wish to spend time touring New Zealand after their hunt with us. For those that are seeking detailed assistance in planning any touring options, we put you in contact with our USA based travel agent who has been working with us for over 30 years. Their friendliness, knowledge of New Zealand, booking systems and ability to recommend options to suit you is second to none.



THE BOOKING PROCESS

Visit us at shows, email or call to enquire. We provide the hunting options, prices and all the travel detail to consider, creating a perfect package to suit you. Hunts booked with us include international flight discount vouchers and the option of using our LA based travel agent to coordinate travel. It's all about ensuring you are completely prepared and the travel logistics are as easy as possible. As we are often taking bookings three years out, it is advisable to deposit for dates that best suit you. You are required to pay a US\$1,000 deposit to pencil in dates, making up the first 50% deposit to confirm your hunt with us. We accept electronic transfer (wire), Visa, MasterCard, Amex, cash and cheques. Our hunts generally run for an average of five days, often starting on a Monday morning where we meet you at Christchurch International airport.
